Join the State Attorney's Office/17th circuit in Fort Lauderdale, FL. as a prosecutor.

We recruit during the 2nd and 3rd years of law school. We hire Florida Bar members who have demonstrated an interest in litigation and/or criminal law through course work and internships. Clinical participation is also preferred. We also recruit attorneys with prosecutorial experience for lateral hires.

Our prosecutors manage a large volume caseload, are in court daily and prosecute numerous trials. Training mentoring and supervising are provided by senior attorneys. This is truly a unique opportunity to learn to become a first class trial attorney and to serve and protect the community.

Entry level salary is \$50,000 annually, which coupled with our generous benefits package benefits is comparable to \$82,242.32 annually. (See entry level attorney benefits summary). A three year commitment is required.

Internships

The State Attorney's Office, 17th Judicial Circuit offers placement for law students who wish to volunteer during their law school career. These are non-paying positions available year – round, with a class of interns during the summer.

Placement is also available for certified legal interns through law school clinical programs.
